## Paid Internship Opportunity

The AFT Local 1904 is looking for a dedicated, hard-working Montclair State U. student with an interest in learning more about the work of unionism, political activism, contract law, and/or social policy. This paid internship extends from Sept 1st through June 30th. The internship requires solid research, writing, computer and communications skills, including experience with social media. The intern reports directly to the Internal Vice President and will assist with multiple projects, as appropriate. Work assignments will be based on how the intern's skills and interest best interface with the evolving needs of the union.

## How to Apply:

We rely on both academic success and a prospective intern's interest in learning more about the work of the American Federation of Teachers. We have no formal application. Students interested in an internship with the AFT Local 1904 should send the following **by August 15, 2015**:

- 1. Cover letter that explains your:
  - Interest in becoming an intern at the AFT Local 1904
  - What you expect to learn during this internship
  - What you have to offer the AFT Local 1904
  - Why you want to learn more about the labor movement
  - The time period for which you are seeking an internship.

## 2. Resume

- Include a list of any relevant coursework and contact information (phone and email)
- Writing sample
