Modified Work Schedules for Professional Staff Summer Season – 2008-2011

- 1. All professional staff and librarians shall work an extended day/four-day workweek schedule in the weeks during the months of June, July, and August, 2008-11 as specified in Appendix I. The extended day schedule will not be followed during the week that includes the July 4 holiday. All personnel will follow usual work schedules during this week.
- 2. Professional Staff and Librarians shall work at least 35 hours per week and meet usual administrative expectations following work schedules to be approved by their respective unit directors.
- 3. The summer workweek schedule shall be Monday through Thursday. In instances where an office/unit is to be open on a five-day per week schedule, each professional staff person shall arrange with his/her office director whether he/she will work extended hours Monday through Thursday or Tuesday through Friday, or whether he/she will work normal hours over the five days. Sprague Library is an unusual five-day per week schedule with coverage needed Monday-Thursday and Saturday. As in prior years, coverage in Sprague Library will be handled consistent with past practice. Disagreements concerning arrangements for coverage for any five-day schedule shall be decided by the next highest level of supervision or, if necessary, by the President's designee in consultation with the Union's designee.
- 4. Sick leave and vacation days shall be charged at the rate of 1-1/4 days per day of absence for those on the standard four-day workweek schedule.

5. This agreement shall continue through August 30, 2011.
